



Biography

Born in Annecy in 1992, Adrien started his musical career in 2010 with the guitarist Guy Zenouda. He discovered jazz and latin music with Philippe Cocogne, his teacher at the conservatory of Cagnes sur mer during four years. Then he registered in the jazz piano class of Robert Persi and arrangement class of Pierre Bertrand at the national conservatory Pierre Cochereau in Nice.

Musically open minded, his influences are various from Ruben Gonzalez to Brad Mehldau, including Michel Camilo, Chick Corea, Rebeca Mauleon, Osmany Paredes, Jon Lord, Red Garland, Wynton Kelly, Oscar Peterson, Bill Evans.

On the french Riviera stage he works with Philippe Ciminato, Vitorino Rodrigues, the Maupity band with which he performed in Canada and the HipHop'N'Mic band.

In 2015 he created his own quintet in which he reveals his various influences.

He produced his first album Euforia in August 2017 and settled in Paris to discover new musical opportunities.



The quintet

The Adrien Brandeis Quintet is a rich colourful Jazz.

The main influences of his compositions include Bill Evans, afro caribeen musics, as well as more modern musicians such as Chick Corea, Michel Camilo and Richard Bona.

The sound of this new quintet combines tradition and modernity. A sensitive melodious and punchy cocktail between euphoria and melancholy.



Since 2017 Adrien Brandeis has been playing his music in France, Europe, Asia and has received several rewards:

- Audience choice reward at the Tremplin Jazz à Porquerolles in 2017
- Finalist in many competitions such as the Nice Jazz festival, Jazz in Vannes, the Cavalaire Jazz festival.

The quintet's musicians

The regular members who play with Adrien Brandeis are Joachim Poutaraud (alto and tenor sax), Guillame Leclerc (bass), Philippe Ciminato (percussion) and Félix Joveniaux (drums).

Other musicians have participated in this project during replacements such as Jean-Marc Maudet(percussion) David Brkljacic (sax) Ludovic Guivarch(drums), Kevin Tardevet, Adrien Locso, Roman Dauneau (bass), and Orlando Poleo (percussion).

In Paris, Adrien works with a different rythm section with the cuban Félix Toca (bass) and Yoann Danier (drums).

A native of Nice and percussionist,
Philippe Ciminato is a versatile and
independant musician who played
around the world with the
most famous artists such as Salena
Jones, Indra Lesmana, Horacio "El
Negro" Hernandez, Toninho Horta,
Steve Thornton, Lenny Castro, Gerald
Albright, Dwiki Dharmawan and
World Peace Orchestra, Baba
Sissoko, Guy Strazz, Andy Suzuki,
Alonso Gonzalez, Joe Rosenberg,
Mounir Troudi, Kamal Mussalam,
Mimmo Cafiero, Lica Cecato...and
many other fabulous musicians.



His extensive travels around the globe led him to study the Afro Caribeen, the Brazilian ,the west African musics and the Indonesian gamelan. He applies this rich heritage through a combination of musicality and dexterity on drums from all over the world.



Born in Paris in 1986, Guillaume Leclerc starts his career in 2009 when he enters the Theatre of Paris as bass player in the Jazz trio « Liberjazz » until 2012. In 2010 he works with the group Manouch'k and goes on tour with their first album. Many concerts in France, Belgium and Croatia. Creation of the second album « K-ravan » released in 2015. At the same time, he discovers the Eastern

Europe music when beginning to play with the group Aalma Dili. Very attached to hip hop, he collaborates with the collective Paris Reality Check with Zoneraze. He is also involved in other projects, drifting between Jazz, Swing and french variety with Laurence Saltiel, Margot Cavalier, Clara Marchina, « DD swing » and « Quai des brumes ».

Joachim Poutaraud beginns his musical career through Jazz and improvisation in 2012 in Paris with a self taught approach of a young japanese saxophonist Daïsuke Kato. Then follows the creation of different projects such as the Collectif III Tone based on sound experimentation.



In 2013 he starts his studies at the CNR in Nice with Jean-Marc Baccarini who brings him a more open minded vision of his instrument. At the end of 2015 he enters the collective Hip'Hop'n'M, that enables him to perform on the local scene in Nice.



Ludovic Guivarch started playing drums at the age of 7. After his bachelor's degree and several musical experiences with different rock groups, he enters the drum jazz and contemporary music classes at the CRR in Nice. Year after year, in addition to the practice of his instrument, he develops his musicality ,sharpens his musical ear and takes an active interest in arranging and composing.

We can now find him playing on barrels with the Nice rapper Mas Kit, the Hip Hop N Mic band, the jazz electric III Tone group or the young HipHOp NTC group.

In October 2016 he enters the Adrien Brandeis quintet project, very much interested by the pianist's compositions.

His current references are the drummers Herlin Riley, Lewis Nash, Bill Stewart, Brian Blade, Leon Parker, Questlove.

The « Euforia » album

Recorded the 15th and 16th August 2017at studio 26 (Antibes), Euforia is Adrien Brandeis's first album as a composer.

This album is entirely produced by Adrien Brandeis.

It was recorded at studio 26 by Fred Bétin, mixed at studio 149 (Nice)by Grégory Lampis and mastered at Altho studio (Lyon) by Alexandre Potteck. Marc Giacomoni did the cover and Julien Sanine the video recording.

The album is available on all download platforms, and pressed in 1000 copies.

It includes eight original compositions.
